JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

The petitioner/accused is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.7 dated 20.01.2014, under Sections 324, 323, 506, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code and (Section 326, IPC added later on), registered with Police Station Kot Bhai, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

The dispute is between two families over a piece of agricultural land in the Village. There is a civil litigation pending between the accused and the complainant party.

As per the allegations of the complainant-Vakil Chand, on the day of occurrence, Jasvir Singh @ Jassa along with his family members and servant attacked the complainant and his servant-Nachhattar Singh @ Chhati Singh. The petitioner is alleged to have armed with *Gandasa* and alleged to have inflicted *Gandasa* blow on the left wrist of the servant-Chhati Singh, which has been opined to be grievous in nature.

It was contended that the said injured-Chhati Singh himself has filed a complaint (**Annexure P-5**) against the complainant-Vakil Chand and other family members with the allegations that a false case has been foisted upon the present accused party. It is further submitted that the petitioner has since joined the investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Sham Sunder, concedes that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, interim pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 16.11.2015, is made absolute/confirmed.
