This is a petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure preferred by Rajiv Kumar, seeking pre-arrest bail, feeling apprehension of his arrest, in case FIR No. 135, dated 09.10.2014, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468 and 471 of IPC, registered at Police Station Division No. 6, Industrial Area, Economics Offence Wing, Ludhiana.

2. During the pendency of present petition, matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court to explore the possibility of amicable settlement between the parties and with the sincere efforts of Mediation and Conciliation Centre,

parties have arrived at a settlement/agreement, which has already been reduced in writing on March 13, 2015 and has duly been sent to this Court.

3. Since, matter has been settled between the parties and further that in compliance of order dated November 14, 2014, petitioner has already joined the investigation, order dated November 14, 2014, is made absolute.

4. However, parties shall be bound by the terms and conditions of agreement/compromise and, in case, either of the parties violates or wriggles out from the terms and conditions of the compromise, aggrieved party shall be at liberty to challenge this order.
