Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are major and there is no legal impediment to their marriage. They have solemnized marriage. Their marriage is opposed by respondent Nos.4 and 5, who are the family members of petitioner No.1.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Aashima Mor, Advocate for the UT Chandigarh, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-UT Chandigarh. A complete copy of the paper book has been furnished to the learned counsel for the UT Chandigarh,

in the Court.

Without expressing any opinion with regard to validity of marriage and on the merits of the assertions made in the petition, the instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh, to consider and decide the representation dated 29.10.2015 (Annexure P-5) of the petitioners and provide necessary protection to them, if he is satisfied that the life and liberty of the petitioners is threatened at the hands of respondent Nos.4 and 5, in accordance with law.
