Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurdeep Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 05.11.2014, the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custody is not required. He further submits that recovery is yet to be effected.

Since the petitioners have joined the investigation and recovery can even otherwise be effected, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 05.11.2014 is hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioners will join the investigation as and when required by the police and will not tamper with evidence or hamper the investigation and will not leave India without permission of the Court and will comply with the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
