Prayer is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No. 217, dated 02.08.2015 (**Annexure P-1**) for the offences punishable under Sections 323, 452, 506, 148, 149 and 326 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Ellenabad, District Sirsa.

As per allegations, the petitioner-Satbir Singh alongwith his cousins are alleged to have gone house of the neighbour Balkar Singh and inflicted injuries upon them.

It is contended that the role attributed to the petitioner that he alongwith Babu Lal and Geeta caught hold of Balkar Singh and his sister Amarjit Kaur while others inflicted injuries upon them.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 17.08.2015.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from SI Nihal Singh, does not refute the custody period of the petitioner and further submits that investigation qua the petitioner are over.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the custody period of the petitioner and the facts of the case as noticed above, this Court finds that petitioner/accused-Satbir Singh deserves the concession of regular bail and as such he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.
