AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 7.

Mr. S.K. Shorey, Advocate has entered appearance on behalf of respondents No.4 and 5 and prays that parents of the girl want to meet her.

Allowed as prayed for. The respondents No.4 and 5-parents talked to her daughter-petitioner No.1 in my Chamber but still the petitioner No.1 wants to stay with petitioner No.2-husband.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age

petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Matriculation Examination Certificate (Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 06.10.1997 whereas petitioner No.2 has placed on record a copy of Secondary School Examination Certificate (Annexure P-2) depicting his date of birth as 29.06.1994. They have also moved a representation before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-SSP, Hoshiarpur to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-5).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
