Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 CrPC is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.282 dated 26.7.2014 for having committed the offences punishable under Sections 304-B/34 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Panipat, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that none of the witnesses, as examined during the trial, have deposed against the petitioner. Even the complainant Sushil Kumar PW-4

and Laxman Dass PW-5, father of the deceased, have not deposed against the petitioner.

During the course of arguments, when learned State counsel was confronted with the aforesaid facts, he does not dispute the same. However, he submits that the case is now fixed for 15.5.2015 before the trial Court and an application under Section 311 CrPC has been moved for examination of the persons who had received the chemical reports.

Considering the fact that none of the witnesses i.e. the complainant or the father of the deceased have deposed against the petitioner and in case the aforesaid application under Section 311 CrPC is to be processed, it may take sufficient long time, the petitioner is admitted to regular bail subject to his furnishing of bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Needless to say that the observations made here-in-above shall not be considered as reflection of any opinion on the merits of the main case, in any manner, during the course of trial, as the same has been recorded for a limited purpose of deciding the present petition for regular bail.
