Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Jasbir Singh states that petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation.

Mr. Vikram Jeet Singh, Advocate appearing for the complainant states that petitioner is a habitual offender. He further states that petitioner was convicted in a complaint case but was released on probation. Another FIR was already registered against him. However, this Court is to confine to the facts alleged in the present case.

Since the petitioner is no longer required by the police for further investigation, therefore, interim bail granted by this Court on 05.11.2014 to the petitioner is made absolute.

Petition is accordingly allowed.
