The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.71, dated 5.7.2015, registered under Sections 307/324/323 of the IPC, at Police Station Lohian.

Custody certificate by way of affidavit of Iqbal Singh, Deputy Superintendent, Central Jail, Jalandhar, has been filed. As per the same, the petitioner has been in custody for four months and six days.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the injured has been discharged from hospital and in view of the custody period undergone by the petitioner, he should be released on bail.

Learned AAG Punjab has not denied the factual assertions.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.
