FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

The allegations in this regular bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. against the petitioner-Shyambir are that he along with his co-accused Dr. Manish Kumar used to facilitate fabrication of injuries on willing persons to enable them to lodge false cases against their opponents on payment of illegal gratification. It is *inter alia* argued by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 09.07.2015 and that the principal accused Dr. Manish Kumar has already been allowed bail by this Court vide order dated 21.9.2015 and that the petitioner cannot be connected with the commission of offence as he is an ordinary person having no role.

Though, on behalf of the State the bail application is stoutly opposed by Mr. Munish Sharma, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, however, having regard to the fact

that similarly placed co-accused has been allowed bail by this Court, thus, in view of the principle of parity, without adverting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition for grant of regular bail is allowed. Petitioner be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
