Petitioners have preferred this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeking regular bail in case FIR No.101 dated 07.11.2014, registered at Police Station Bakhshiwala, District Patiala, under Sections 458, 294, 109, 323, 325, 506, 148, 149, 459 IPC.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Amrinder Singh Klar, AAG, Punjab, has accepted notice on behalf of respondent(s)-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

As per the allegations of the prosecution, two specific injuries have been attributed to co-accused Gola Singh and only he entered the house of complainant and remaining accused were standing outside. The petitioners are in custody since 06.01.2015. They are not required for investigation or interrogation purposes and nothing is to be recovered from them as they are also in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time and no useful

purpose will be served by keeping the petitioners in custody till the disposal of the case.

Therefore, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merit of the case, the present petition is accepted and the petitioners are ordered to be released on regular bail on their furnishing bail bonds in the sum of ₹30,000/- with one surety in the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
