RITU BAHRI, J.

This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and further to ensure that they may not be harassed by respondent Nos. 4 to 13, as the petitioners have solemnized marriage against the wishes of their family members.

Upon notice, reply on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3, in the shape of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, City-II, Patiala, has been filed in Court, wherein it has been stated that on 03.11.2014 Rajinder Pal Sharma-respondent No.4 made an application (Annexure R-1/T) to the police with regard to kidnapping of his daughter Nandni Sharma. Thereafter, he made a statement (Annexure R-2/T) to the effect that he has come to know that his daughter, Nandni Sharma, has solemnized marriage with Manpreet Singh-petitioner No.2. She is 21 years of age. Now, he has no objection to the marriage of her daughter. Statement of Nandini Sharma-petitioner No.1 has also been recorded on 19.12.2014 (Annexure R-3/T) to the effect that she

has solemnized marriage with Manpreet Singh on 05.11.2014 and now she is residing happily with her husband at his house.

In view of the reply filed, no further orders are required to be passed in this petition.

Disposed of accordingly.
