This order will dispose of two petitions, one (CRM-M-37852 of 2014) for quashing of FIR No.117 dated 24.07.2014, under Sections 341, 323, 324, 506, 406, 498-A, 120-B IPC, Police Station Phase 8, S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali) and the other (CRM-M-37853 of 2014) for quashing of cross

version recorded vide DDR No.37 dated 24.07.2014, under Sections 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC, in the aforesaid FIR, both on the basis of compromise.

It has been informed that the matrimonial dispute has been settled and the parties to marriage have been residing together. Statements of the parties have been recorded before the Illaqa Magistrate and a report has been received that the matter has been compromised voluntarily without any threat or coercion.

Following the full Bench judgment of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, the aforesaid FIR and all other criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise subject to the condition that parties will not indulge in any similar activities again. In case of any violation of the said condition, it will be open to the parties to approach this Court for revival of the proceedings.
