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**M.M.S. BEDI, J (ORAL)**

The petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.59 dated 18.2.2014 (Annexure P1) under Sections 420/406 IPC registered at P.S. Kapurthala City, District Kapurthala on the basis of compromise.

The said FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2 Balbir Singh alleging that the petitioners had cheated and misappropriated the amount of complainant to the tune of Rs.1,40,000/- on the promise to send the son of the complainant to Malaysia on work permit but he was sent to Chennai and thereafter to Malaysia where he was harassed and not provided any job.

The matter has been compromised. The statements of the parties have been recorded. Parties were directed to appear before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kapurthala. After recording the

statements of the parties, a report has been received to the effect that the matter has been compromised voluntarily.

Following the judgment of Full Bench of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, I am of the opinion that there is no reason for proceeding with the trial when the grievance of the complainant stands settled and he is not interested in pursuing the case further.

Petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom, are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise subject to the condition that petitioners will deposit a total sum of Rs.10,000/- with the Punjab State Legal Services Authority, Chandigarh and another total sum of Rs.5,000/- with the Punjab Police Welfare Fund, Sector 9, Chandigarh within a period of one month and produce the proper receipt before the trial Court.
