Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.271 dated 20.7.2014 registered under Section 382 IPC and under Sections 21 and 22 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar City.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has been regularly appearing before the learned trial Court. He was on regular bail. However, since petitioner wrongly noted down the date of hearing as 9.10.2015 instead of 5.10.2015, he could not appear before the learned trial Court on 5.10.2015. She further submits that petitioner is ready and willing to surrender before the learned trial Court within a period of one week from today and learned trial Court may be directed to consider the bail application of the petitioner, on the basis of totality of facts and circumstances of the case, brought to the notice of the learned trial Court.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned trial Court within a period of one week from today. The learned trial Court shall consider the bail application of the petitioner, keeping in view the totality of facts and circumstances of the case, brought to its notice, at the instance of the petitioner, by passing an appropriate order, strictly in accordance with law, but at an early date.

Disposed of, accordingly.
