Petitioner seeks quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise.

The FIR No. 111 dated 11.11.2011 under Section 381, 411 IPC Police Station Mahilpur, Hoshiarpur was registered at the instance of Rakesh Kumar respondent No.2 alleging that the petitioner had committed theft of electronic items from the shop of the complainant like T.Vs and videocon dish DTH as he had been working with the complainant.

The matter was referred to the trial Court for recording statements of the parties. Report has been received indicating that the matter has been compromised voluntarily without any inducement, threat or

coercion after recording the statement of the complainant voluntarily.

In view of the judgement of **Kulwinder Singh vs. State of Punjab and others 2007(3) RCR(Crl.)1052**, the FIR can be quashed on the basis of compromise in the present case.

In view of the above discussion, the instant petition is allowed and the aforesaid FIR along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom is hereby quashed on the basis of compromise.
