This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in a case registered against the petitioner under Sections 7(1) of Essential Commodities Act, 1955, 13/18/21-B of Insecticides Act, 1968, Sections 420, 186, 120-B IPC, Sections 7,8,28(1)A, 28(1)D, Section 35 of Fertilizers Control Order 1985 and Section 7,13(1)D of Prevention of Corruption Act (added on 3.10.2015) at Police Station Raman, District Bathinda, vide FIR No.122 dated 2.9.2015.

Allegation against the petitioner is that he took Rs.8.00 lacs as bribe from Shubham Goyal and Vijay Kumar for allowing them to keep spurious pesticides and insecticide. Stand of counsel for the petitioner is that this allegation has been levelled by Gurdeep Singh on the basis of hear say. Petitioner is stated to be in custody since 5.10.2015. Investigation of the case is still pending and trial is yet to commence.

Plea for bail has been opposed by the State counsel on the ground that allegations against the petitioner are serious.

Heard.

Keeping in view the contentions raised before this court, period of incarceration of the petitioner and the fact that trial is yet to commence, I am of the considered view that no useful purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner in custody any longer. Thus, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Bathinda.
