Petitioner allegedly represented to the complainant that he was the owner of the property in question and entered in agreement to sell consequent upon which he received an amount of Rs.30 lacs from the complainant as part payment.

The case of the petitioner is of total denial. He submits that neither he signed any document nor made any such agreement.

The copy of agreement of sale is produced which shows that the stamp paper was purchased by Mohammad Sajid, i.e. the petitioner and the agreement was signed by him in Hindi. He also signed the register of stamp vendor in Hindi whereas the vakalatnama filed in the Court in the present petition is signed by him in Gurmukhi.

According to the respondent as also counsel for the complainant, the petitioner is absconding. Counsel for the petitioner submits that if any interim protection is granted to him, he will join investigation.

Since it is admitted that the petitioner is absconding meaning that he is evading arrest and it is submitted on his behalf that he will appear only if some interim protection is granted, the intention of the petitioner is far from good. No relief of discretionary nature can be granted to such a person.

Dismissed.
