Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.363 dated 24.09.2014, registered under Sections 307, 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 IPC and 25 of Arms Act, at Police Station 'A' Division, Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This Court, vide order dated 08.12.2014, directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner would be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Magistrate in connection with abovesaid case FIR.

Learned State counsel stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for interrogation.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, the order dated 08.12.2014 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Petition disposed of accordingly.
