Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the

petitioners in FIR No.3 dated 10.1.2015, under Sections 7, 13(1)(D) and 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, registered at Police State Vigilance Bureau, Rohtak.

This Court vide order dated 18.3.2015, while issuing notice of motion, has granted interim bail to the petitioners subject to joining the investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency/Investigating Officer and to abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by Inspector Sanjeev from State Vigilance Bureau, Karnal, has stated that in terms of the above order the petitioners have joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 18.3.2015 are made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
