Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.46 dated 2.7.2014 registered under Sections 304-B/34 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Garhdiwala, District Hoshiarpur.

Notice of motion was issued vide order dated 12.11.2014 and thereafter arrest of the petitioner was stayed vide order dated 19.11.2014.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during the pendency of the petition, parties have amicably settled the matter by way of compromise. He further submits that on the basis of said compromise, petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of said FIR has already moved by way of CRM-M-5909-2015, wherein notice of motion has already issued for 26.5.2015.

Faced with the above, learned counsel for the complainant also endorses the statement made by the learned counsel for the petitioner. This material fact has been verified by the learned counsel for the State as well,

on the instructions received from ASI Gurdip Singh, Police Station Garhdiwala, District Hoshiarpur. He further submits that parties have amicably settled the matter.

In view of the above, interim protection granted to the petitioner vide order dated 19.11.2014 is hereby made absolute, however, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Disposed of, accordingly.
