AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.268 dated 08.06.2015 registered under Sections 148/149/323/307/447/427 IPC and Sections 25/54 of Arms Act at Police Station Narnaund, District Hisar, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is 75 years old and similarly situated co-accused i.e. Ramesh Lambardar was granted concession of bail by order dated 06.11.2015 passed in CRM-M-

37386-2015 on the basis that he had been in custody for almost 5 months.

Custody certificate by way of affidavit of Surinder Singh Godara, Superintendent Jail, Central Jail-I, Hisar has been filed and the same is taken on record. As per the custody certificate the petitioner has been in custody for 4 months and 15 days.

Learned Deputy Advocate General, on instructions from the Investigation Officer has accepted these factual assertions.

Keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands disposed of.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
