The instant petition is for quashing of FIR No. 63 dated 14.05.2003, under Sections 326,324,323,148 & 149 IPC registered at Police Station Sardulgarh, District Mansa and all the consequential proceedings arising out of the same.

The learned counsel for the petitioner at this stage prays that the present petition be disposed of by giving direction to the Juvenile Justice Board, Mansa to expedite the trial since the petitioner intends to go abroad.

Learned State counsel has no objection to aforesaid plea of learned counsel for the petitioner.

The alleged incident pertains to the year 2003 and the present proceedings are coming in the way of the petitioner to go abroad. Therefore, the Principal Magistrate, Juvenile Justice Board, Mansa is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously, preferably within a period of six months from the date of receipt of copy of this order in the light of Article 21 of the Constitution of India viz. right to life & personal liberty-Fundamental right of speedy trial.

Accordingly, petition is disposed of.
