The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.PC for direction to the respondents for conducting an impartial, proper and fair investigation and to present the challan after concluding the investigation in FIR No.159 dated 27.5.2013 under Sections 420, 406, 409, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Ballabgarh, District Faridabad.

On 7.9.2015, learned counsel for the State had submitted that in the case in hand, the cancellation report was prepared as far back as on 7.7.2014 but the same could not be filed in the Court because of the pendency of the present petition.

In view of the aforesaid development, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press this petition, however, seeks liberty to avail remedy as warranted by law.
