MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in terms of Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR no. 77 dated 1.10.2014 registered under Sections 406, 498-A, 506 IPC at Police Station Kanwan, District Pathankot.

Efforts at Mediation and Conciliation Centre had failed.

It is contended that the dispute inter se between the parties erupted on account of matrimonial discord, the marriage being 16 years old.

Notice of motion had been issued and interim protection was granted to the petitioner on 10.11.2014 subject to the condition that the petitioner complies with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and will also pay a sum of Rs.30,000/- as interim maintenance.

It is not in dispute that the petitioner has since joined the investigation to the satisfaction of Investigating officer which fact is not controverted by the learned State counsel on instructions from HC Manohar Lal. It is further stated that petitioner has also paid a sum of Rs.30,000/- as interim maintenance.

Thus, without commenting upon the merits of the case but noticing the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer and also complied with the terms of the order dated 10.11.2014, instant petition is accepted. Interim directions dated 10.11.2014 are hereby made absolute, however subject to the condition that the petitioner continues to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
