Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, in a case arising out of FIR No. 110, dated 16.08.2014, registered at Police Station Division No.5, Jullunder, District Jalandhar City, who has been booked for having committed the offence punishable under Sections 363/366 and later on added Section 376 IPC.

Reference has been made to the regular bail application of co-accused Sangeeta in CRM-M-42253 of 2014 (Annexure P-2) whereby it has been stated that petitioner Aarti and Sangeeta were named by the prosecutrix in her statement recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C. It is further submitted that the petitioner is not related to the main accused. It is Guria and other accused who were responsible for the offence and they all were residing in the same courtyard.

Proclamation proceedings against Guria, Saktu and one Dhani Ram are pending. The case of the petitioner is

identical to the case of Sangeeta.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and with their able assistance gone through the material available on record.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner, this court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail during pendency of the trial of the present case, subject to her furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Jalandhar.
