The petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.636 dated 29.07.2015, registered under Sections 364, 387, 323, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Gurgaon.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the parties have amicably settled their dispute.

The complainant, duly identified by the Investigating

Officer, is present in the Court. The learned counsel for the complainant admits the factum of compromise having been effected between the parties.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that though the petitioner has joined the investigation, but two co-accused are yet to be arrested.

Heard.

The petitioner has already joined the investigation and the matter has been compromised between the parties.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 05.11.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
