Petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in FIR No.138 dated 26.09.2015 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Chattiwind, District Amritsar (Rural).

Notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Manjeet Singh, Police Station Chattiwind, Amritsar (Rural), submits that in compliance of the order passed by this Court, petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no more required for the purpose of any further investigation.

In view of the above, instant petition is allowed and the order dated 05.11.2015 passed by this Court, is hereby made absolute, however, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

However, it is clarified that the observations made by this Court in order dated 05.11.2015 shall not cause any kind of prejudice to the interest of either of the parties at the time of final adjudication of the civil suit.
