Report dated 18.11.2015 sent by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioner Keshav Goyal as well as of complainant Mandeep Singh and Ravinder Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052,** FIR No.203 dated 10.09.2014 under Sections 408,420,465,467,468,471 and 477-A IPC, Police Station, Sarabha Nagar, Ludhiana and all other

consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.
