Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No.121 dated 15.3.2010, under Sections 382, 406, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar (Annexure P-1) on the basis of compromise/affidavit dated 30.10.2014 (Annexures P-2 and P-3).

This Court vide order dated February 10, 2015 passed the following order :-

“Learned State counsel seeks time to file reply.

May do so within three weeks.

Adjourned to 31.3.2015.

In the meanwhile, the parties are directed to appear before the trial Court within three weeks, where the statements of the parties shall be recorded. After recording the statements of the parties, the trial Court

shall report to this Court whether the parties have compromised the matter and if so, report to this Court whether the same is genuine and without any pressure.”

Pursuant to the aforesaid order dated February 10, 2015, the parties appeared before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar on 27.2.2015 and their statements were recorded. On the basis of the statements so recorded, learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar has submitted her report dated 3.3.2015, wherein the entire matter has been settled between the parties. The report indicates that the parties have settled the dispute willfully and without any pressure. The compromise is stated to be genuine.

Keeping in view the factum of compromise effected between the parties dated 30.11.2014 and the law laid down by this Court in the case of **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR (CrI.) 1052 (P & H)**, this petition is accepted and FIR No.121 dated 15.3.2010, under Sections 382, 406, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar and the consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
