RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner, by way of instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure ('Cr.P.C.' for short), seeks a direction to the official respondents to carry out an effective as well as early investigation in FIR No.570 dated 20.07.2013 under Sections 417, 420, 466, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Bhiwani, District Bhiwani.

Notice of motion was issued and pursuant thereto, reply by way of affidavit dated 10.02.2015 of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Bhiwani was filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

While referring to the averments taken in Para 7 of the reply, on merits, learned counsel for the State submits that two status reports had already been submitted, before the learned trial Court.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the petitioner refers to an order dated 02.03.2015 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Bhiwani, to contend that status report was still awaited from Investigating Officer.

Be that as it may, present petition is disposed of, with a direction to Superintendent of Police, Bhiwani-respondent No.2 to look into the matter, ensure completion of an effective and early investigation, if not already completed and direct the concerned Investigating Officer for submitting the final status report before the learned trial Court at an early date and in any case, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Disposed of, accordingly.
