This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.200 dated 23.06.2015 registered under Sections 384,388,419,420,120-B and 506 IPC at Police Station Civil Lines Kaithal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, no offence is made out against the petitioner. The petitioner has been implicated falsely just to take the revenge and as a counter-blast to various complaints made to the police, which are still pending. As per allegations the alleged incident is of the year 2012 but the FIR has been registered in the year 2015 and delay has not been explained. No role has been attributed to the petitioner. Petitioner is in custody since 30.06.2015. Nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner. No useful purpose would be served by keeping her in custody. Co-accused of the petitioner namely, Jai Prakash and Rajinder have been released on regular bail on 16.11.2015 and 19.11.2015 respectively.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State has not disputed the custody period as well as release of co-accused on regular bail.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and also the fact that co-accused of the petitioner have already been released on regular bail; the petitioner is in custody since 30.06.2015; trial may take long time to conclude and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in custody, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on her furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Kaithal.
