Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurdev Singh Police Station, Women Cell, District Ludhiana submits that the petitioner has since joined the investigation and that the articles that have been duly detailed in the memo of the Investigating Officer have been recovered from the petitioner and that now nothing is to be recovered from him.

Though, the same is sought to be opposed on behalf of the complainant, however, in the light of the fact that in the investigation part of the prosecution story no such allegations were levelled and that the other accused have been found innocent.

In view thereof, *ad interim* order dated 06.11.2015 passed by this Court are made absolute. However, on the request of counsel for the complainant to narrow down the

differences between the parties, if any, parties are directed to personally appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Center of this Court on 14.12.2015.
