Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.185 dated 29.09.2014, under Sections 341/323/354/506/34/354-D IPC registered at Police Station City Rupnagar, on the basis of compromise. As per the allegations in the FIR, respondent No.2 Sukhwinder Kaur and her daughter were intercepted on the road by the petitioners and an attempt was made to kidnap the daughter.

Claiming that the matter has been compromised the present petition was filed. Parties were directed to appear before the trial Court and get their statements recorded. A report has been received that the matter has been compromised voluntarily without any threat or coercion.

This petition is allowed in view of judgment in **Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052.**

The aforesaid FIR and all the criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise subject to petitioners depositing a sum of Rs. 20,000/- in the shape of bank draft within a period of one

month. The bank draft will be handed over to the investigating officer, who will hand over the same to the complainant Sukhwinder Kaur as compensation for unnecessary harassment caused to the complainant.
