ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

This is the third petition filed on behalf of the petitioner seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 138 dated 22.08.2012, registered under Section 15 of the NDPS Act, Police Station City South, District Moga.

Heard.

Counsel for the petitioner has disclosed that the petitioner was granted anticipatory bail and had put in appearance before the Court and had never mis-used the concession. It was pleaded that another case was registered on 23.03.2014 under the NDPS Act. It was pleaded that the petitioner came to know about the raid and fled from the spot but

his vehicle remained behind and out of fear of arrest in that FIR, the petitioner could not attend the Court and the bail was cancelled on 27.03.2014 and he was declared proclaimed offender subsequently. It was pleaded that the petitioner was granted interim bail on 15.10.2015 in FIR no. 28 registered on 23.03.2014 and now he was in a position to appear before the Court.

The order Annexure P-4 shows that the petitioner is yet to join the investigation and the matter has been adjourned to 07.12.2015 though the concession of interim bail had been allowed.

Vide order dated 09.05.2014, the petitioner had been declared proclaimed offender. The excuse taken by the petitioner is that since another case was registered he was running from pillar to post. The second FIR had been registered in March, 2014. The petitioner failed to inform the Court where the trial was pending. The trial has been held up for over a year. No case for anticipatory bail is made out. The petition is dismissed.

The petitioner would surrender before the Court concerned on 26.11.2015. A copy of this order be sent to the trial Court.
