The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.88, dated 15.10.2015, registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B of the IPC, at Police Station Cantt. Bathinda, District Bathinda.

After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw this petition and further states that in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court, a direction may be issued to the trial Court to decide the regular bail application of the petitioner expeditiously.

I find this to be a fair request. Consequently, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn. It is directed that in case the petitioner surrenders

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before the trial Court on or before 27.11.2015 and moves an application for regular bail, the trial Court shall decide the same on merits within two days of its filing.
