In this petition, petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.74 dated 13.10.2014 registered under Sections 406/498A/354/376/511/313 IPC at Police Station Mansa Devi Complex, Panchkula.

During the pendency of the present petition, an amicable settlement between the petitioners and the complainant-Samriti Nandra has taken place by way of mediation through Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

The settlement has been reduced into writing on

05.02.2015 and 09.02.2015 and all the parties have signed the same in token of confirmation. Both the parties have agreed to remain bound by the terms and conditions of the settlement arrived at between them.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that against the FIR in question a cancellation report has already been submitted by the Police to which the complainant has already endorsed no objection for cancellation thereof.

Parties are present in Court and have admitted the abovesaid fact.

In view of above, this petition is dismissed as having become infructuous.
