Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.4 dated 6.1.2015 under Section 61/1/14 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Gate Hakima, Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

This Court vide order dated 6.2.2015 had granted interim bail to the petitioner subject to his joining investigation and complying the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from MHC Davinder Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 6.2.2015 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
