This is an application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for placing on record documents i.e. zimni orders and statements before Id. Trial court as Annexure P-9 (colly) and P-10 (colly).

Documents (Annexures P-9 and P-10) are taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

CRM stands disposed of.

Main case

The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.43, dated 26.02.2013, under Sections 420, 406, 467, 471, 34 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Bhupani, District Faridabad

(Annexure P-2) and consequential proceedings arising out of the same, on the basis of mutual settlement/compromise dated 26.08.2014 (Annexure P-3).

In compliance of order dated December 16, 2014, fresh report dated January 21, 2015 of learned Judicial Magistrate has been received along with statements of parties.

As per statements of parties, compromise has been arrived at between the parties voluntarily without any undue influence, force or coercion. Even otherwise, the matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

So, in view of above circumstances and in view of pronouncement reported as Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another; 2012(4) RCR(Criminal) 543, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No.43, dated 26.02.2013, under Sections 420, 406, 467, 471, 34 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Bhupani, District Faridabad and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua petitioners.
