The present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.'), has been filed seeking pre-arrest bail in FIR No.82 dated 12.09.2014, registered under Sections 328, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Rampura, Distt. Bathinda.

The learned counsel for the petitioners refers to Annexure P-2, and contends that no poison, as alleged, was detected. The present FIR has been registered to pressurize and prevent co-accused, Amandeep Kaur, from registering FIR under Section 498-A IPC, against the complainant and her grandson, Avtar Singh. He further states that in pursuance of order dated 09.01.2015, passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 09.01.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
