This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. to direct the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Dhuri to grant bail to the petitioner on appearance in complaint case No.104 of 5.6.2015.

After arguing for some time, the learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not wish to press this petition on merits but liberty may be granted to the petitioner to surrender before the Court below and move an application for regular bail and a direction may be issued to the Court to decide the said application expeditiously.

I find this to be a fair request. Let the petitioner surrenders before the Court below on or before 14.12.2015 and moves an application

for regular bail which shall be decided expeditiously by the Court but in any case within 2 days on merits. It is made clear that in case the petitioner does not surrender before the Court in the aforesaid manner the present petition would be deemed to have been dismissed.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.
