AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to take appropriate action against respondents No.5 and 6 who are allegedly threatening to implicate the petitioners in false and frivolous cases on false complaint filed by respondent No.7.

Learned counsel has argued that in this connection the petitioner has also moved representation dated 01.10.2015 (Annexure P-3) to the respondent No.2 and at this stage they would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and decide their

representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar is directed to look into the matter/representation (Annexure P-3) and in case it is found that any action is required to take whatever action he deems necessary as per law.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
