Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.10, dated 14.01.2013, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, IPC registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar City along with all the consequential proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of compromise.

The FIR was registered at the instance of respondent No.2-Vinod Rouli alleging that he had entered into a agreement of sale with the petitioners and other accused. He had also paid the entire sale consideration but the petitioners never turned up for registration of the sale deed and kept delaying the matter and also threatened the complainant.

Now the parties are stated to have entered into a compromise. Challan has not been presented as yet in the case.

This petition is disposed of with a direction that the complainant will appear before the Investigating Officer within a

period of 15 days and get his supplementary statement recorded. Statement of any other effected person, if any, be also recorded by the Investigating Officer within the above said period. In case, on the basis of supplementary statements recorded, the investigating agency is of the opinion that cancellation report is to be presented, it will be open to the Investigating Officer to present the same before the concerned Court. On complainant appearing before the Illaqa Magistrate with no objection, it will be open to the trial court to accept the cancellation report.
