This is a petition under Section 439 of Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.185, dated 01.09.2012, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 34 IPC registered at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

As per allegations of the prosecution, the sale deed in respect of the hotel of the complainant was registered in the name of co-accused Sonia who happened to be the wife of the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 08.07.2014. Learned counsel for the complainant is present and has stated at bar that the matter has been compromised. He has also placed on record the certified copy of the statement in which complainant has not supported the case of the prosecution.

So, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition stands accepted, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Gurdaspur.
