PARAMJEET SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising out of FIR No.42 dated 07.05.2012 under Sections 419, 420, 468, 471, 12-B IPC and Section 18, 20, 19 of Transplantation of Human Organ and Tissue Act, 1994 registered at Police Station Phase-VIII, District SAS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner vehemently contended that the petitioner is in custody from 13.02.2014. All the accused including the Doctor who have taken out the alleged organ have been released on

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bail. Petitioner was only an employee who was performing the duty on administrative side, otherwise he has no role. The consent is alleged to have been taken by the petitioner through videographs and he is allegedly involved in the conspiracy of the alleged scam of taking out human kidneys illegally

Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case that the co-accused including the main accused namely Shakeel, Amitab Pandey, Vikas, Archana Goyal, Parshotam, Manju Pandey, Faggu @ Sachin and Ashok Pandey and Doctor concerned i.e Ajinder Bains have already been granted bail. The petitioner is behind the bars since 13.02.2014. Case is at the stage of examination of prosecution witness.

Without going into the merit of the contentions raised by the learned counsel for the petitioner, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Mohali
