The present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.), has been filed seeking pre-arrest bail in FIR No.165 dated 18.09.2015, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, at Police Station Sector 3, Chandigarh.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that matter stands compromised between the parties.

The learned counsel for the U.T. Administration, on instructions, admits the factum of the matter having been compromised between the parties. Further states that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not

required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 06.11.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
