This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for quashing of FIR No.105 dated 05.07.2013, registered under Sections 323, 324, 326, 148, 149 and 307 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC'), at Police Station Bhogpur, Jalandhar and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties.

Heard.

Vide order dated 31.01.2014, the parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court, for getting their statements

recorded. In compliance thereof, report of JMIC, dated 21.04.2014 has been received, wherein, it has been noticed that the compromise has been reached in between the parties voluntarily, without any pressure or coercion through the respectables of the locality.

In view of the above and the law laid down by Hon'ble the Supreme Court, in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**', *2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and Narinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab, 2014 (6) SCC, 466*, this Court feels that no purpose would be served in keeping the proceedings alive.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. FIR No.105 dated 05.07.2013, registered under Sections 323, 324, 326, 148, 149 and 307 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC'), at Police Station Bhogpur, Jalandhar and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner(s).
