1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?
2. To be referred to the Reporters or not?

AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

At the very outset, learned counsel states that in the representation (Annexure P-5) the name of respondent No.2 has inadvertently been mentioned as Superintendent of Police instead of Senior Superintendent of Police and prays that the same may be corrected.

Allowed as prayed for. Registry is directed to make necessary correction.

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent No.4.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their

parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Matriculation Examination Certificate (Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 16.12.1994 whereas petitioner No.2 has also placed on record a copy of Matriculation Examination Certificate (Annexure P-2) depicting his date of birth as 24.02.1988. They have also moved a representation before the Senior Superintendent of police, Nawan Shahar, SBS, Nagar (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without advertng to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of police, Nawan Shahar, SBS, Nagar to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-5).

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Criminal Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
