MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in terms of Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR no. 125 dated 2.7.2013 registered under Sections 498-A/406 IPC at P.S.City Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the parties are agreed that the dispute had arisen on account of a marital discord which has since been resolved and therefore further proceedings to dissolve the marriage etc. shall be taken.

Learned counsel for the respondent-complainant states that in view of above facts he has no objection if the bail is confirmed.

Having regard to the aforesaid facts that the matter has been settled, I am of the view that no useful purpose would be served by keeping the threat of arrest alive. Hence, instant petition is accepted. Interim directions dated 5.12.2013 are hereby made absolute, however subject to the condition that the petitioner continues to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
