Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 12 dated 05.04.2011 under sections 420, 376, 354, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Behrampur, District Gurdaspur (Punjab), on the basis of compromise.

Parties were directed to appear before the trial Court to make statements regarding compromise. After recording the statements of the parties, a report has been sent by the trial court that the matter has been compromised without any threat or coercion. It is reported that petitioner No. 1 and the complainant have started living together.

In view of the matrimonial dispute having been settled, I do not find any reason not to permit the compounding.

Petition is allowed. The aforesaid FIR and all other criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed on the basis of compromise, following Full Bench judgment of this Court in ***Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR (Cr.) 1052*** subject to a further conditions that petitioners will not commit the similar offence again. In

case of violation of the said condition, it will be open to the complainant to approach this Court for revival of the proceedings.
